

Traffic dangers at school

The Board is greatly concerned about the risks to parents and children from traffic around Brenton/Kepa intersection, and to children walking along Kepa Road.

We have recently written to various agencies about these risks and requested urgent action to address them. And we plan to make changes on the school grounds too.

But YOU also have a role to play in reducing the risks – please comply with the advice and information on the back of this flyer. You may well save a life – including yours!

Do's and Don'ts!!

DO! Queue here – safe and good view of Brenton traffic

DO! Wait for your children by the Church on the North of Kepa Road

DON'T! Turn right out of Brenton Place – its dangerous and you stop traffic flow. Go left and around Nehu St, Coates then onto Kepa

DON'T! Queue here – yellow lines and traffic hazard

DON'T! Block traffic flow on Brenton Place – work around the parked cars

DO! Stay in or close to your car to reduce queue delays

DO! Queue as tightly as possible on school grounds and fill parking spaces first

DON'T! Try to come in via the exit gate – it blocks traffic and creates danger
